What a King's High girl learned from Angela Brazil

In her own words, Catherine Bott tells us this:

'Catherine Bott (KHS 1964-71) progressed, over 7 years, from Priory to Eastgate, from being the girl with the hand-me-down dance dress (fluidly draped apple-green crepe de chine, but alas, not the primary coloured belted poplin that everyone else wore to prance about in) to Editor of the Ilex, stalwart of the school play and Deputy Head Girl, before leaving the school under a very considerable cloud, having refused to pursue Oxbridge entrance, instead sticking to her insane determination to train as a singer in London. Two headmistresses later, she finally made it to her first ever Speech Day, as guest speaker, where she had the great pleasure of presenting prizes to at least one bright daughter of a King's High contemporary.

'Between the Leaving Girls' Service and that Speech Day, Catherine studied at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama in London, after which she spent two years singing everything from Bach to Berio with the Swingles before beginning a distinguished solo career specialising in baroque music. Among her many recordings are Bach's St. John Passion and Purcell's Dido and Aeneas. She has also premiered and recorded works by contemporary composers Craig Armstrong, Jonathan Dove and Michael Nyman.

'A couple of years after addressing the girls of King's High (and the irreplaceable Miss Lenygon) on the usefulness of discouragement, she made another speech, at a classical awards do, which led to an offer from BBC Radio 3. In her ten years at the BBC she wrote and presented more than 300 editions of The Early Music Show and was one of the regular hosts of live evening concerts. In 2013 she moved to Classic FM, where her Sunday-night programme, Everything You Ever Wanted To Know About Classical Music, is now in its sixth year. On two evenings a week she also presents The Full Works Concert, and she occasionally nips up to Salford to present Pick of the Week on Radio 4.

'Catherine is a Fellow of the Guildhall School of Music and Drama and an Honorary Fellow of Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Dance.'
