

KS3 Uniform Overview



- 1. Hair colour: predominantly single tone, within range of natural hair colours. Hair accessories: should match uniform colours (black, blue, white) or the natural colour of the hair.
- 2. Make up: natural look, no visible make-up, mascara, false eyelashes, acrylic nails, nail varnish, fake tan etc.
- 3. Blouse: White revere blouse (short or long-sleeved)
- 4. Jumper: Blue V-neck jumper or sleeveless slipover.
- 5. Blazer: worn daily for arrival and departure from school, when moving around school, and for all formal occasions. Worn with sleeves rolled down.
- 6. Mock kilt: worn on the knee or below at all times. The style should not be altered in any way and the skirt must not be rolled or hitched up.

Trousers: regulation design from the Uniform Shop worn on the ankle Or

Summer dress (optional only in the Summer Term, Autumn Term 1): worn on the knee or below at all times.

Please allow for the fact that skirts or dresses may ride up.

7. Tights or socks: Black tights or black knee-length socks.

White ankle socks (optional only in the Summer Term, Autumn Term 1).

- 8. Shoes: black leather shoes with arch support, heel no more than 2.5 inches in height, not trainer style.
- 9. Jewellery: Wrist watch and one small, plain stud in ear lobe with bottom of earlobe visible. No facial piercing jewellery allowed.

Summer dress (optional only in the Summer Term, Autumn Term 1): worn at approximately knee level or below at all times.

A dress or skirt worn at 5cm or more above the knee does not meet the uniform code. Please allow for the fact that skirts and dresses may ride up.

7. Tights or socks: Black tights or black knee-length socks.

Or

White ankle socks (optional only in the Summer Term, Autumn Term 1).

- 8. Shoes: black leather shoes with arch support, heel no more than 2.5 inches in height, not trainer style.
