School Uniform Supply

Stevensons is the official supplier of school uniform (worn in KS3 and KS4) and PE kit (worn in KS3, KS4 and Sixth Form) to King's High School and items can be purchased online www.stevensons.co.uk or at the WISF onsite shop. Please find details of shop opening times on the website.

Nearly-new uniform is sold termly in school at the King's High Association for Parents and Staff (KHAPS) sales. Dates for these sales and information on how to sell uniform are published in the school calendar. The next sale is on Saturday 17 June from 10.00 am to 11.00 am in King's High Dining Hall.

King's High sports kit from September 2023

New kit was introduced in September 2021 and from September 2023 all students are required to wear it.

Phasing in of new King's High uniform

Our new uniform was introduced in September 2022 and becomes standard for all students in September 2024. The transitional phase continues until July 2024. During this transitional period, current items of uniform will continue to be sold at our KHAPS nearly-new uniform sales to maximise the reuse of garments in line with our focus on the environment and sustainability.

During the transitional phase, students may:

- wear the full current uniform
- wear the full new uniform
- wear either blazer with either uniform.

Our summer dress option has not changed and can be purchased new from Stevensons or nearly new from KHAPS sales.

School Uniform and Appearance Code (Years 7 – 11)

The Uniform and Appearance Code has been drawn up through extensive consultation with students, staff and parents. Their views have helped shape a clear whole-school approach to uniform and appearance which aims to be fair, inclusive, reasonable, and transparent. The justification for each aspect of the code was considered, paying due attention to wellbeing and inclusivity. Please refer to the code for guidance on purchasing appropriate items.

Students should arrive at school daily, looking smart in their appearance and wearing full uniform, unless a formal exemption has been made e.g. for a school trip. All uniform, games kit and personal possessions must be clearly marked with the owner's name.

This should be taken into consideration when ear piercing is being planned as, for safety reasons, there can be no exceptions. An item of religious jewellery may be worn discreetly only if written request is received from a parent and a jewellery pass issued. No facial piercing jewellery is permitted.
